The International Journal of Driving Sciences (IJDS), an initiative of HAN University of Applied Sciences, proudly welcomes you to the 1st IJDS symposium "Driving the Intelligent Vehicle".

The symposium takes place on 14 and 15 June in Haarlem, The Netherlands. In this symposium, intelligent vehicle technologies integrate with human factors in applied research. Researchers and engineers from academia, industry and government meet and present their latest findings and state-of-the-art technology. The first presentations start on 14 June at 13:00h and will be followed by a dinner in the evening. The symposium ends on 15 June with the Award for Young Talent and drinks & bites at 16:00h.

The symposium focuses on the following themes:

- Driver Vehicle Interaction
- Interaction between the Driver and Accident Avoidance Technologies
- Driver Vehicle Adaptation

Conversation session (optional)

On 14 June, prior to the symposium the conversation session "Breaking Contradictions of Driving Automation" is organized. This conversation session investigates controversial topics through interactive case study reviews. Experts in the field introduce the case studies. Do note that places are limited to 70 persons. Registration is required.

Pitches Young Talents

We want to encourage young talents to become more active and visible. As such, talented Bachelor or Master students are given a platform at the IJDS Symposium where they present their project or thesis related to the symposium topics, in the form of an elevator pitch. The best elevator pitch will be awarded a prize based on a voting by the audience.

The symposium, as well as the dinner will be organized at the <u>Philharmonie</u>, Lange Begijnestraat 11, in Haarlem, a charming music hall located next to the town square and the St. Bavo Church. The medieval city hasn't lost its old historic character: small courtyards, plazas, canals and churches dominate the historic center. Haarlem is situated at 20 km from Amsterdam and <u>easily attainable</u> from Schiphol Airport.

After the deadline rooms still can be booked based on availability.
